The Mind School: Lu Hsiang - Shan And Wang Yang - Ming

The philosophy of the mind school already took definite form in Lu Hsiang - Shan (II39-II93), who said, "The universe is identical with my mind, and my mind is identical with the universe". This is because both the mind and the universe are conceived as expressions of the moral law.

"There is no moral law beyond events and there are no events beyond the moral law."

This idealistic tendency developed until it reached its climax in Wang Yang-Ming (1473-1529) to whom the mind and reason are one and the same thing. The mind itself is identical with reason. The controlling power of the body is the mind. When the idea rests on serving one's parents, then serving one's parents is a thing... Therefore, I say that there is neither reason nor thing apart from the mind.
