P. and Gujrat, Chedu-gudu in Tamilnadu and Karnataka, Wandikali in Kerala, Kabaddi in Noth Indi, Zabarganga in Punjab and Ha-du-di in Bengal is purely an Indian game.3 In fact it could be the most ancient form of outdoor sports for the entire human rece.

In the history of Kabaddi traced back to epic age. However there are two schools, one goes back to prehistoric period and the other starts from epic period. The game is essentially an Indian one, through there is no clearcut evidence about its origin. In that particular episode, Arjuna's son, Abhimanyu was engaged in a fierce battle with a set of 7 figures. They skillfully defended themselves by instituting a difficult blockade called Chakravyuha.4

STATUS OF KABADDI ON NATIONALAND STATE LEVEL

Further the development of Kabaddi has also been traced in the medieval period of Maratha history during which the colleagues of Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj and developed their strategy of guerillas warfare through the

The popularity of Kabaddi went on increasing in different forms and areas. 5 After Maharashtra Bengal has contributed for the popularity of the game in 1923. Thus form Thus form 1938 regular national level competitions were organized regularly in these games only males were included.

In United Bombay state scanty efforts were made for the development of Kabaddi. However, Kabaddi got a boost when independent linguistic state of Maharashtra was established in 1960. Bombay state kabaddi association here in after called as MSKA. The sports activities began in Marathwada from 1930.6 Kabaddi is treated as root of guerilla warfare and like Marathas under Chahatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, Peshwas as well as early crusaders of 1857 also used different sports activities for creading public opinion.

RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

Physical education social research requires careful analysis of facts. These facts can be derived from study of ideas, individuals and organizations. The study of Maharashtra State Kabaddi Association is related to physical education.
