The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) an autonomous body, has been established by the University Grants Commission (UGC) in 1994, in pursuance of the recommendations.

Under the new methodology introduce by NAAC w.e.f April, 2007, the higher education institutions are assessed and accredited by a two step approach.

The NACC functions through its general council and executive committee where educational administrative policy makers are a senior academicians from a cross section of system of higher education are represents. India has one of the largest and dives education systems in the world.

The mission statement of the NAAC aim at translating the NAAC's vision into action plans and endeavor as given below.

- 1.To away for periodic assessment and accreditation of institutes of higher education or with thereof, or specific academic programmes or projects.
- 2.To stimulate the academic environment for promotion of quality in teaching-learning and research in higher education institution.
- 3. To encourage self evolution, accountability, autonomy and innovations in higher education.
- 4. Undertake quality related research studies consultancy and training progammes and
- 5. To collaborate with other stakeholders of higher education for quality evaluation promotion and sustenance.

Contributing to National Development: Most of the Higher education institutes have a remarkable capacity to adopt changes, and at the same time pursue the goals and objectives that they have set forth for themselves.

Unit of NAAC Accreditation: Institutional Assessment and Accreditation the unit of Accreditation is refered to the institutions as a whole with its academic and administrative may be either a university or a college or a single department, offering a particular subject of specialization.

This number increased to 702 universities and 36,000 colleges in 2013, with over 14 million students enrolled there in.

Management of library and information services in university the library system normally consist of a central environment defines the use of the library in terns of the strength and size of the text and research collection. The central library supports the general information requirements of the users, both for study and research.

Working Hours: This parameter refers to opening and closing hours of the library

Library advisory Committee: The purpose of the library advisory committee is to advise for implementing the library policies with the following constitutions and functions.

Committee shall consist of the

- 1. A senior professor to be nominated by the head of the institute.
- 2. One faculty representatives each academic department.
- 3. Three representatives each from UG. PG and research scholar.
- 4. Librarian; the member secretary.

Functions: Library committee members should consider policy matters regarding central library including the policy for procurement of books and journals and render advice to the purchase committee for library procurement. To consider and put forward the views of faculty members regarding books, journals selection, ordering process etc.

Manpower Development: Qualifications and experience of the librarian and library staff should as per the rules and norms of UGC/AICTE/etc.

Infrastructure of the Library: Library location, whether the library have a place of its own with proper planning and organization of space, proper furniture, with necessary quality and quantity, display racks, magazine racks etc. e-library services are provided to users type of user and programmmes offered. The library have networking facility.

The library should have an approval policy on the collection development support, introduction of new services, support in terms of fund, annual increase of budget, binding procedure removal of absolute books and policy on loss of books and an ongoing commitment of the institutions.

Collection: The library is required to provide varied, authoritative and up-to-date resources that support its mission and the needs of its users. Collection currency and strength be maintained through judicial weeding out policies.

Book bank facility, special collections even with limited budget, the library may explore ways, such as open access sources to provide quality resources in the most efficient manner possible.
