CHHAVI RAJAWAT

KIRAN BEDI

She has served her area of expertise with full conviction, as well as made entire hearted commitment to numerous social causes. A previous tennis player, the multi-skilled social extremist from Amritsar is credited for cutting down the quantity of violations against ladies in West Delhi amid her administration. She presented a few changes at Tihar Jail, which increased overall recognition and won her the

In 2003, Kiran turned into the primary Indian lady to be selected as a Police Advisor to the Secretary-General of the United Nations in the Department of Peace Keeping Operations. AMRITA DEVI

ARUNA ROY

In 2011, Aruna was named as one of the '100 most persuasive individuals over the world' by Time Magazine.

PHOOLAN DEVI
