RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

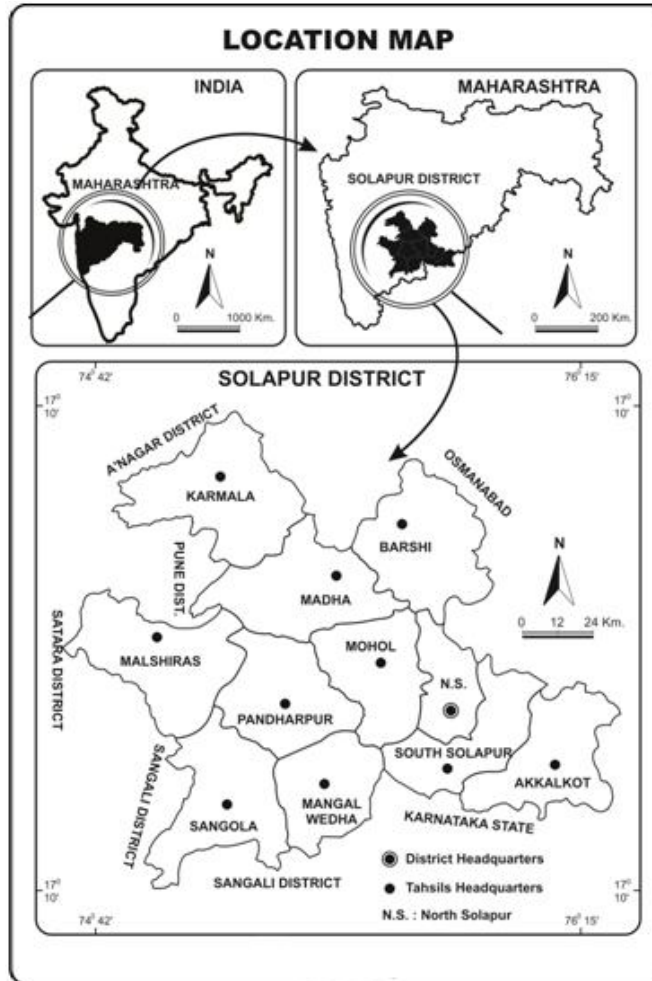
I have used primary and secondary tools for the essay writing essay. It has also been visited by historical heritage sites.

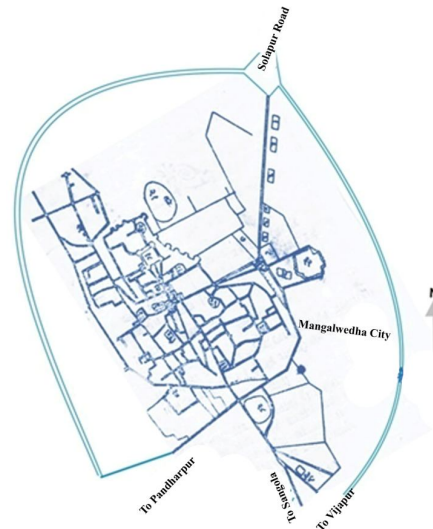
Neglected Mangleda Taluka in Rural Tourism:
